Series History:

Penn is 1-0 all-time in its head-to-head series against Waldorf, winning the only meeting last year 16-9.

Lincoln Cavanagh (Sr., Williams, Northeast Hamilton HS) rushed for 114 yards and a touchdown in the win. **Jake Jenkins** (Sr., Newton, Northwest Missouri State) secured the win by recovering a fumble and returning it 20 yards for a touchdown early in the fourth quarter.

Coaches:

Todd Hafner is in his fifth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 19-25 career record.

Hafner led his 2007 squad to a 5-6 record, including a 3-4 Midwest League mark.

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when it was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 44 all-conference players and six All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

The Statesmen A Year Ago This Week:

Penn held off Waldorf for a 16-9 victory on the road.

In addition to Cavanagh's rushing tally, **Ryan Van Dalen** (Jr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) completed nine of 19 passes for 140 yards. Cody Hackett hauled in five receptions for 87 yards.

The Warriors A Year Ago This Week:

Waldorf opened its 2007 slate with the loss to Penn.

On paper, the Warriors actually looked much better, with a 360-276 edge in total yardage. Marcus Lewis had 139 rushing yards and Scott Gregson completed 17 of 24 passes for 152 yards.

Statesmen Top Offensive Players from 2007:

Van Dalen completed 119 of 276 passes for 1,718 yards and 11 touchdowns in 2007.

Four of Van Dalen's receivers had over 100 yards receiving. Adam Randall led the team in both receptions (39) and receiving yards (587), while **Skyler Crouch** (Jr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS) had a team-best four touchdowns. The junior finished the year with 25 receptions for 541 yards.

Mario Whitney paced the backfield with 136 rushes for 794 yards and 11 touchdowns. Cavanagh also contributed in the rushing game with 440 yards and three touchdowns.

Waldorf Top Offensive Players from 2007:

Quarterback Ryan Kerns completed 62 of 156 passes for 564 yards and three touchdowns in 2007, while Scott Gregson also saw plenty of action behind center as he completed 28 of 50 passes for 272 yards.

Erskinte Henderson, with 18 receptions for 228 yards, and Shawn Sosebee, with 18 receptions for 224 yards, were both major targets for Warrior quarterbacks.

Marcus Lewis was the workhorse in the backfield, rushing the ball 267 times for 1,123 yards and six touchdowns.

Statesmen Top Defensive Players from 2007:

Clint Peery, despite missing two games due to injury, still led the team with 110 tackles (8.5 for loss) in 2007. **Travis Grosshans** (Sr., Plattsmouth, Neb., Northwest Missouri State) was next with 82 stops. Peery also topped the Statesmen with 3.5 sacks.

Jenkins led the defensive unit with five interceptions, while **Steven Strasko** (Sr., Eddyville, Palomar CC) had four and Cale Carlson tallied three.

Waldorf Top Defensive Players from 2007:

Bryan Bjorkland headed the defensive unit with 97 tackles, while Branden Mohs had a squad-high 11.5 tackles for loss. Jake Foley led all players with three interceptions.

Statesmen Top Special Teams Players from 2007:

Mark Gronzalski owned a 39.5 yard average over 66 punt attempts, while **William Brasel** (Jr., Warrensburg, Mo., Missouri Southern) was 21-26 on extra points and 6-14 on field goals.

Shawn Dume handled much of the kickoff return responsibilities and owned a 23.1 yard average over 20 attempts. Crouch was Penn's best punt returner with a 6.1 yard average over 14 attempts.

Waldorf Top Special Teams Players from 2007:

Marcus Lewis also punted for Waldorf and owned a 35.5 yard average over 75 attempts. Gray Spencer was 1-2 on field goals and Brandon Chenevert was 4-6 on extra points.

Jake Foley was the team's best returner with a 5.8 yard average over nine punt return attempts and a 19.1 yard average over 23 kickoff return attempts.

Coach Hafner Says:

On preseason practice:

"We had a really good preseason and were able to keep everybody here, which is something we have struggled with in the past. I really like the type of players we will have representing our University on Saturday afternoons."

On preparing for Waldorf:

"We expect Waldorf to send the same type of option attack that we have been preparing for in practice, so that should really help us out. Both teams will have a very similar look on offense."

"Defensively, they return several key players from a squad that shut us down pretty well a year ago. We still feel very confident that we will get the job done and that our depth will be a major factor in the end."

On the injury front:

"We unfortunately lost our projected starting fullback Travion Johnson to a season-ending knee injury. He will be sorely missed on offense, but hopefully we have some guys who will step up. Otherwise, we just have some minor bangs and bruises that are perfectly normal after a few weeks of preseason practice. We have tried to go light on the guys this week to freshen them up for Saturday."
