SERIES HISTORY: Penn is 2-10-1 all-time in its head-to-head series against Drake, last dropping the Bulldogs 6-5 in 1900. Drake has won five in a row and eight of the last nine against the Statesmen, while the two programs tied 7-7 in 1917.

The last time the two programs met, the Statesmen fell 16-6 on the road in 2004. Penn was outgained just 316-231, but was unable to get on the board until midway through the fourth quarter on a five-yard scoring run by Jer'ronne Johnson.

Rob Freeman and Corey Allen both had an interception each, while Chas Ryan and Tim Tuck each had one fumble recovery as well.

COACHES: Todd Hafner is in his fifth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 19-25 career record.

Hafner led his 2007 squad to a 5-6 record, including a 3-4 Midwest League mark.

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when it was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 44 all-conference players and six All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

Chris Creighton is in his first year as head coach at Drake.

Creighton comes to Drake from NCAA Division III Wabash (Ohio). At Wabash, he ranked fourth among active NCAA Division III coaches in career winning percentage (63-15) over seven years, winning four conference titles and competing in three playoffs. He also coached 13 All-Americans at Wabash.

Creighton coached at Ottawa (Kan.) for five years as well, helping the program to one conference title and two NAIA

Overall, he has been named Conference Coach of the Year on four occasions.

Creighton also served as an offensive coordinator at Concordia (Ill.) and Manchester (Ind.) prior to his head coaching stints.

An accomplished player as well, Creighton was an All-American quarterback at Kenyon (Ohio).

He earned a bachelor of arts degree from Kenyon in 1991 and a master's degree from Concordia (Ill.) in 1993.

THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK: Penn fell for the first time in 2008 in a 28-14 loss to Marian (Ind.) in an MSFA crossover game.

The host Knights scored on their first three possessions to pull out to a quick 21-0 lead and never looked back.

Already down 28-0, the Statesmen rallied valiantly in the fourth quarter with two touchdowns, but it was not enough.

Ryan Van Dalen (Jr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) was most of the Penn offense as he completed 11 of 25 passes for 207 yards and a touchdown completion to **DeMarco Sanders** (Fr., Horn Lake, Miss., Horn Lake HS).

Van Dalen also rushed for the other score as he tallied a team-high 52 yards on the ground.

Chris Weigle (Jr., Meridian, Idaho, Mountain View HS) added 34 rushing yards on the afternoon.

THE BULLDOGS LAST WEEK: On a rain-soaked field, Drake was shutout by Lehigh (Pa.) 19-0.

The Bulldogs were held to just 125 yards of total offense and, when they did have scoring changes, also struggled in the kicking game, missing attempts of 45 and 25 yards.

THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Penn had a rough go of it in a 71-7 loss to St. Francis (Ind.) in an MSFA crossover game.

Mario Whitney scored the lone Statesmen touchdown on a 53-yard scoring run in the second quarter.

THE BULLDOGS A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: After a sluggish start, Drake pulled away in the second half to drop Wisconsin-Platteville 20-7.

The Bulldogs trailed 7-3 at halftime, but exploded for 167 yards and two touchdowns in the third quarter. Scott Phaydavong rushed for 149 yards, while Coe Ingle threw for 183 yards and rushed for one touchdown in the win.

The 3-0 start for Drake matched its best start since the 2000 season.

COACH HAFNER SAYS

On the Marian game:

"Against Marian, it was a matter of us not playing with any enthusiasm and with the exception of our defense in the second half and our offense in the fourth quarter, we didn't seem to want to be there and didn't play hard."

"This is something we can work on, but the guys have to want to do it on their own as well."

On Drake:

"Even if the stats haven't shown it, Drake is very good and played well in its first two weeks."

"They play hard and physical and cause turnovers. Offensively, they have had struggles, but considering the weather last week at Lehigh, it's understandable."

"We will have to be at the top of our game in order to compete with them."

On Penn:

"Our biggest concern right now is us being us and being confident in ourselves."

"We certainly spent a lot of time this week preparing for Drake, but we did a lot just trying to get better ourselves. It is time for our younger guys to step up and for our veterans to take on leadership roles."

STATESMEN TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Van Dalen remains Penn's best offensive threat as he has transformed into a strong multiple-option quarterback.

Through the air, the junior has completed 13 of 31 passes for 261 yards and a touchdown (no interceptions) and has also rushed 34 times for 197 yards (5.8 avg.) and three scores.

Chris Weigle (Jr., Meridian, Idaho, Mountain View HS) has also produced in the running attack with 83 yards and two touchdowns.

Sanders has a team-best six receptions, but **Skyler Crouch** (Jr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS) leads the receiving crew with 150 yards on just three catches.

DRAKE TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Ingle paces the Bulldog offense as he has completed 25 of 49 passes for 219 yards and a touchdown.

Michael Lahart is the best rushing threat with 73 yards.

Zach Brower holds the squad lead with seven receptions and the lone touchdown, while Spencer Cady has a team-best 66 receiving yards.

STATESMEN TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: **Trevon Green** (Jr., Gaffney, S.C., Gaffney HS) and **Stephen Patterson** (Fr., Detroit, Mich., Highland Park Community HS) are tied for the team lead with 20 tackles each, while **Travis Grosshans** (Sr., Plattsmouth, Neb., Northwest Missouri State) is next with 19 stops.

Terrance Flukers (So., Miami, Fla., Edgewater HS) has a squad-best two interceptions, while Grosshans and **Brock Peery** (Fr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS) both have one fumble recovery each.

DRAKE TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: Cale Hunt is far and away the most productive Bulldog defender with 25 tackles,

while Andy Green and Tim Harvey both have one interception. Five different Bulldogs have already recovered a fumble in this young 2008 season.

STATESMEN TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: **William Brasel** (Jr., Warrensburg, Mo., Missouri Southern) is currently 7-8 in extra points, while **Michael Harris** (Jr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) has punted 12 times for an average of 31.9 yards.

Crouch leads all returners with a 15.3 yard average in punt returns, while **Dexter Shelton** (Fr., West Point, Miss., West Point HS) heads the kickoff return side with three attempts for an average of 25.7 yards.

DRAKE TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: Logan Rees is 2-2 in extra points and 1-2 in field goal attempts, while Brandon Wubs has punted 14 times for an average of 40.1 yards.

Richa Courtney owns a 21.3 yard average over six kickoff returns, while Zach Brower has returned two punts for an average of 9.0 yards.
