SERIES HISTORY: Penn is 3-1 all-time in its head-to-head series against Taylor, having won the first three meetings (from 2002-2005) but then dropping last year's contest 29-26.

The Trojans rushed out to a 23-7 lead at the start of the third quarter in last season's game, and though Penn battled hard, it could not overcome the deficit in the three-point loss.

Mario Whitney had a huge game with 210 yards rushing on 28 attempts, while **Ryan Van Dalen** (Jr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) struggled from the pocket, completed 14 of 30 passes for 158 yards and four interceptions.

Both teams had issues keeping the ball as the Statesmen committed six turnovers while Taylor lost possession four times.

COACHES: Todd Hafner is in his fifth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 19-25 career record.

Hafner led his 2007 squad to a 5-6 record, including a 3-4 Midwest League mark.

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when it was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 44 all-conference players and six All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

Ron Korfmacher is in his first year as head coach at Taylor.

Korfmacher moves up the ladder after spending 23 years as an assistant coach in the program. From 1985-2005, he served as the recruiting coordinator for the Trojans.

A graduate of Taylor in 1983, he received his master's degree

THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK: Penn failed to produce much of any offense in a 36-0 loss to Drake two weekends ago.

Van Dalen had a good portion of the offensive success with 70 rushing yards on 15 attempts and 63 passing yards on four-of-11 passing.

THE TROJANS LAST WEEK: Taylor was pounded 55-7 by #4 St. Francis (Ind.) in its Mideast League opener.

The Trojans were outgained 596-260 and watched as the Cougars jumped out to a 49-0 lead. Josh Cook rushed for over 100 yards (111 on 20 carries) to pace Taylor.

THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Penn could not get out of the gate in last year's 29-26 loss to Taylor in week four.

The Statesmen fell behind 17-0 and never fully recovered, despite putting up its fourth-highest point total of the campaign.

THE TROJANS A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Trennen Kidder and Brandon Hurst both passed for over 100 yards to lead Taylor over Penn 29-26 in week four.

Ian Brown made possibly the biggest play of the game as he returned a blocked punt 32 yards for a touchdown at the start of the third quarter. Paul Passiales blocked the punt.

STATESMEN TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Van Dalen remains Penn's best offensive threat as he has transformed into a strong multiple-option quarterback.

Through the air, the junior has completed 17 of 42 passes for 324 yards and a touchdown and has also rushed 49 times for 267 yards (5.4 avg.) and three scores.

Chris Weigle (Jr., Meridian, Idaho, Mountain View HS) has also produced in the running attack with 109 yards and two touchdowns.

DeMarco Sanders (Fr., Horn Lake, Miss., Horn Lake HS) has a team-best seven receptions, but **Skyler Crouch** (Jr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS) leads the receiving crew with 193 yards on just five catches (38.6 avg.).

TAYLOR TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: The 1-2 punch of Cook in the backfield and Shaun Addison at quarterback leads the Trojan offense.

Cook has rushed 87 times for 409 yards and four touchdowns, while Addison has completed 47 of 83 passes for 472 yards and three scores.

Three Taylor players have hauled in over 100 receiving yards, led by Trevor Terrell with 160 yards. Ryan

Magnuson is the top threat for the team with a team-best 16 receptions and two touchdowns.

STATESMEN TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: **Trevon Green** (Jr., Gaffney, S.C., Gaffney HS) leads Penn with 30 tackles, while **Travis Grosshans** (Sr., Plattsmouth, Neb., Northwest Missouri State) is next with 25 stops.

Terrance Flukers (So., Miami, Fla., Edgewater HS) has a squad-best two interceptions, while Grosshans and two others all have one fumble recovery each.

TAYLOR TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: Travis Smith leads the team with 24 tackles, while Passiales has 22 stops.

Marcellus Burto leads Penn with two interceptions, while Jeremy Prudhomme has three sacks and Chris Wheeler has two fumble recoveries.

STATESMEN TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: **William Brasel** (Jr., Warrensburg, Mo., Missouri Southern) is currently 7-8 in extra points and 0-1 in field goals, while **Michael Harris** (Jr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) has punted 21 times for an average of 31.6 yards.

Crouch leads all returners with a 13.3 yard average in punt returns, while **Dexter Shelton** (Fr., West Point, Miss., West Point HS) heads the kickoff return side with three attempts for an average of 25.7 yards.

TAYLOR TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: Nick Davis is 6-6 in extra points and 2-5 in field goal attempts and has also punted 11 times for an average of 34.7 yards.

Ian Brown owns a 22.5 yard average over six kickoff returns, while as a team Taylor has returned just three punts for a total of two yards.

COACH HAFNER SAYS

On the Drake game:

"We played with a lot of energy, but unfortunately we hurt ourselves with turnovers and penalties. We have addressed that and will be ready to play this week."

On Taylor:

"We feel that we are as healthy as we have been all year. The week off really helped and we have had some great practices. We have that beginning-of-the-season feeling again.

"Offensively, their runningback is tops in the MSFA and they try to run everything through the ground game. Defensively, they are very big up front and have a solid secondary."
