**SERIES HISTORY:** This is the first-ever gridiron meeting between William Penn and Peru State.

**STATESMEN IN NAIA RANKING:** Despite last week's 24-14 loss to #11 McKendree (Ill.), Penn is still ranked with one national vote in the NAIA's seventh regular season poll.

The Statesmen are unofficially tied for 32nd with this week's opponent Peru State as well as Virginia-Wise.

**COACHES:** Todd Hafner is in his sixth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 26-29 career record.

Hafner led his 2008 squad to a 7-4 record, including a 5-2 Midwest League mark. The seven wins are the most for the program since 1976. For his efforts, Hafner was named Midwest League Coach of the Year.

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when the team was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 58 all-conference players and eight All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

Terry Clark is in his eighth season as head football coach at Peru State, owning a 28-46 record entering this campaign.

A member of the 1990 NAIA National Championship team, Clark returned to Peru State in 2000 to serve as the defensive coordinator.

He then spent the 2001 campaign as defensive coordinator at Dakota State (S.D.) before coming back to PSC in 2002 to become the head coach.

Clark also has collegiate coaching experience at Mary (N.D.) and prep experience at Auburn HS in 1991.

Clark earned his bachelor's degree in physical education and social and behavioral science from Mary in 1996 and completed his master's degree in education from Peru State in 2006.

**THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK:** Penn could not pull off back-to-back upsets over ranked opponents in falling 24-14 to #11 McKendree (Ill.) last Saturday.

**Ryan Van Dalen** (Sr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) rushed for a game-high 138 yards and a score, but the Statesmen fell into a 21-0 hole and could not dig themselves out. Penn committed the only turnover of the game, which the Bearcats turned into a touchdown in the third quarter.

**PERU STATE LAST WEEK:** The Bobcats held off Waldorf 24-6 last Saturday.

Nate Moore rushed for 155 yards and Curtis Thompson completed 17-of-26 passes for 247 yards and three scores. Cody Wallinger was his top target, hauling in nine passes for 89 yards and a touchdown.

Peru State forced three Warrior turnovers.

**THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK:** Penn flew out to a four-score lead at halftime and cruised to a 35-13 win over Iowa Wesleyan in Week Nine of 2008.

Van Dalen rushed for 206 yards and three touchdowns as the Statesmen gained all 397 of their yards on the ground. Lincoln Cavanagh also had a nice performance with 96 yards on 16 carries.

**PERU STATE A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK:** The Bobcats slipped past Grand View 18-17 in Week Nine of 2008.

Peru State picked off four Viking passes as John Noojin was a workhorse in the backfield with 31 rushes for 168 yards and a score. The team ran for 249 yards on the day.

**STATESMEN TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS:** Van Dalen continues to be the spark in the Penn offense in 2009.

The senior leads the ground attack with 154 rushes for 846 yards (5.5 avg.) and 11 TDs, while four other players have also amassed over 100 yards rushing.

Van Dalen has also completed 47-of-109 passes for 1,055 yards and ten scores. **Skylar Crouch** (Sr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS), with 24 receptions for 701 yards and eight scores, and **Bernard Luster** (Jr., Corinth, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC), with 13 catches for 197 yards and two scores, have been a potent 1-2 punch in the receiving corps.

**PERU STATE TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS:** Thompson is the team's catalyst as he has passed for 1,373 yards and 14 touchdowns, while Noojin has rushed for 490 yards and three scores.

Wallinger is Thompson's favorite target, collecting 41 receptions for 502 yards and seven touchdowns.

**STATESMEN TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS:** Dale Woods (Jr., Southaven, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) and Kris Austin (Sr., Oxford, Miss., Lafayette HS) lead Penn with 51 tackles each. Woods also leads the team with 20 tackles for loss, seven sacks, and two forced fumbles (tied).

**Cody Hackett** (Sr., State Center, West Marshall HS) tops the Statesmen with four interceptions.

**PERU STATE TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS:** Derek Derr paces the Bobcats with 65 tackles, while Derek Phillips has a team-best 9.5 tackles for loss.

Quentin Coatney leads PSC with 2.5 quarterback sacks and Max Virus has a Bobcat-high six interceptions.

**STATESMEN TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS:** Cam Shearon (So., St. Peters, Mo., Francis Howell Central HS) is 4-of-10 in field goals and 24-of-27 in extra points.

Penn is utilizing two individuals in the punt game. Hackett has punted 21 times for a 37.3 yard average, while **Michael Harris** (Sr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) has punted 18 times for a 32.6 yard average.

**Andrew Harris** (Jr., Horn Lake, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) leads the team in return average with a 21.3 yard kickoff average (28 attempts) and a 15.8 yard punt average (nine attempts). He has returned one punt for a touchdown.

**PERU STATE TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS:** Zach Kohlhoff is 3-of-7 in field goals and 12-of-18 in extra points.

Kohlhoff is also the lone Bobcat punter with 41 attempts for an average of 37.0 yards.

Virus leads the team in kickoff returns with 13 attempts for an average of 22.1 yards, while Quentin Edelman is the primary punt returner with 13 attempts.
