Greg Youngblood is in his third season as head coach at Waldorf. He owns a 3-19 career record at the University.

THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK: Penn failed to win its final non-conference game of the year, falling 20-12 to Peru State (Neb.) last Saturday.

Mahaska Communication Group (MCG) will also provide television coverage for all home games on its cable network.

SERIES HISTORY: Penn is 2-0 all-time in its head-to-head series against Waldorf, including winning last year's matchup 41-3.

Ryan Van Dalen (Sr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) rushed for 145 yards and two scores, while **Chris Weigle** (Sr., Meridian, Idaho, Mountain View HS) also had a pair of rushing touchdowns.

The Statesmen limited the Warriors to only 148 total yards and forced three turnovers.

SENIOR DAY 2009: Saturday is Penn's final home game of 2009 and the game will also serve as Senior Day. Fifteen individuals will be recognized prior to the game.

COACHES: Todd Hafner is in his sixth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 26-29 career record.

Hafner led his 2008 squad to a 7-4 record, including a 5-2 Midwest League mark. The seven wins are the most for the program since 1976. For his efforts, Hafner was named Midwest League Coach of the Year.

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when the team was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 58 all-conference players and eight All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before

The Statesmen roared to a 12-0 lead after the first quarter, but could not keep the momentum in allowing 20 unanswered points.

Van Dalen was the offensive star with a game-high 129 yards, while **Corey Ketchum** (So., El Dorado Springs, Mo., El Dorado Springs HS) and **Stephen Patterson** (So., Detroit, Mich., Highland Park HS) tallied the rushing touchdowns.

WALDORF LAST WEEK: The Warriors were kept off the board in a 19-0 loss to league foe St. Francis (Ill.) last Saturday.

Jamie Johnson led the offense with 43 rushing yards.

THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Penn closed out its 2008 season with a heartbreaking 45-42 loss to Quincy in Week 11 of 2008.

Van Dalen had a career day with 224 rushing yards and four touchdowns, while also throwing for a score. Unfortunately, in a game where whoever had the ball last was likely to win, the Hawks gained the last possession off a fumbled punt return and Alex Beard hit a game-winning 33-yard field goal as time expired.

WALDORF A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: The Warriors were shut out 41-0 against NCAA Division III Buena Vista in Week Nine of 2008.

Waldorf had over 100 yards rushing, but could not keep the Beavers out of the endzone as they scored in all four stanzas (21 in the first quarter).

STATESMEN TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Van Dalen has been the best threat for the Penn offense in 2009.

The senior leads the ground attack with 177 rushes for 975 yards (5.5 avg.) and 11 TDs, while four other players have also amassed over 200 yards rushing.

Van Dalen has also completed 49-of-122 passes for 1,067 yards and ten scores. **Skylar Crouch** (Sr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS), with 25 receptions for 707 yards and eight scores, and **Bernard Luster** (Jr., Corinth, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC), with 14 catches for 203 yards and two scores, have been a potent 1-2 punch in the receiving corps.

WALDORF TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Deonte Lewis and Erskinte Henderson have paced the offense as two capable individuals in the backfield. Lewis has 358 rushing yards, while Henderson has tallied 322 yards.

RocTerrius Hobbs has completed 61-of-140 passes for 540 yards and a pair of scores. His top threat in the passing game has been Luke Gassman with 23 catches for 283 yards. Henderson has also fared well with 14 receptions for 193 yards and a score.

COACH HAFNER SAYS

On the Peru State game:

“The Peru State game was one of those that we did not play very well. Despite that, we still had a lot of opportunities to win, but when you turn the ball over and put your defense in bad positions, you make it very tough to win.”

On Waldorf:

“We look at Waldorf as a much-improved team. They have come a long since the start of the year. They are doing a lot of good things on both sides. We will need to play well and take care of the ball to win.”

61 tackles, while **Dale Woods** (Jr., Southaven, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) has 60 stops and **Kris Austin** (Sr., Oxford, Miss., Lafayette HS) and **Damon Harrison** (So., Lake Charles, La., Lake Charles Boston HS) have 58 tackles each. Woods also leads the team with 21.5 tackles for loss, seven sacks, and three forced fumbles.

Cody Hackett (Sr., State Center, West Marshall HS) tops the Statesmen with four interceptions.

WALDORF TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: Nate Lidtke tops the Warriors with 70 tackles, including a team-best seven for a loss. He also has a squad-high two forced fumbles and two blocked kicks. Chris Gomez paced the squad with one and a half sacks.

Alex Grunhovd leads Waldorf with two interceptions.

STATESMEN TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: **Cam Shearon** (So., St. Peters, Mo., Francis Howell Central HS) is 4-of-10 in field goals and 24-of-29 in extra points.

Penn is utilizing two individuals in the punt game. Hackett has punted 24 times for a 36.9 yard average, while **Michael Harris** (Sr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) has punted 21 times for a 33.4 yard average.

Andrew Harris (Jr., Horn Lake, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) leads the team in return average with a 20.7 yard kickoff average (31 attempts) and a 14.2 yard punt average (12 attempts). He has returned one punt for a touchdown.

WALDORF TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: Jairo Lopez is 2-of-4 in field goals and 7-of-11 in extra points.

John Lawson has been a very busy punter, averaging 33.2 yards over 47 attempts.

Multi-purpose Henderson also tops the team in returns with 28 kickoff attempts for an average of 15.1 yards and 12 punt attempts for an average of 8.4 yards.
