SERIES HISTORY: Penn is a perfect 7-0 all-time in its head-to-head series against St. Francis (Ill.), including winning last year's matchup 33-27.

Ryan Van Dalen (Sr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) scored four touchdowns (two rushing, two passing), including the game-winning score in the final two minutes of the upset over the #20 Fighting Saints.

The senior completed ten passes for 174 yards and rushed 12 times for 57 more yards. **Skyler Crouch** (Sr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS) made a major impact in the passing game with six receptions for 137 yards and a score. Penn won despite being outgained 431-374.

COACHES: Todd Hafner is in his sixth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 26-29 career record.

Hafner led his 2008 squad to a 7-4 record, including a 5-2 Midwest League mark. The seven wins are the most for the program since 1976. For his efforts, Hafner was named Midwest League Coach of the Year.

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when the team was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 58 all-conference players and eight All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

Mike Uremovich is in his fifth year as head coach at St. Francis (Ill.), entering the campaign with a 13-30 mark.

Uremovich comes to the University from Waynesburg where he served as offensive coordinator for two years. He has also coached at Benedictine and Northern Illinois (graduate assistant) as well as at the prep level at McCutcheon and Providence Catholic, where he graduated from high school.

Uremovich graduated from Purdue with a bachelor's in secondary education in American history and has a master's in continuing adult education from Northern Illinois.

THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK: Penn got back on the winning track with a 65-6 domination of Waldorf in league play last Saturday.

The Statesmen had an outstanding offensive performance with 565 yards, including 446 on the ground. Both marks were just shy of school records.

Van Dalen topped Penn with 169 rushing yards and 117 passing yards, while Crouch caught two long throws for 115 yards and a pair of scores.

ST. FRANCIS (ILL.) LAST WEEK: The Fighting Saints lost a 30-29 heartbreaker to Quincy last Saturday.

John Goolsby hooked up with Ponce Palmer as time expired, but the extra point by Patrick Wright to send USF into overtime failed. It was the second time this fall that the Fighting Saints missed an extra point to force overtime.

Goolsby completed exactly half of his 46 attempts for 291 yards and three scores. Palmer was named MWL Offensive Player of the Week by hauling in six catches for 110 yards and two scores, while Jason Fiske had nine catches for 114 yards.

Connor Krisch rushed for 87 yards on the day. Wright had made three field goals earlier in the game. St. Francis edged the Hawks in total yardage 394-347.

THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Penn did not play a 12th game in 2008.

ST. FRANCIS (ILL.) A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: The Fighting Saints committed too many errors in falling 27-10 to Olivet Nazarene in Week 11 of 2008.

Goolsby threw four interceptions, including one that was returned 98 yards for the day's opening score. St. Francis moved the ball inside the Tiger red zone on six occasions, but scored just twice (TD, FG). Goolsby finished the day with 197 yards passing as the team actually outgained Olivet Nazarene 273-262.

STATESMEN TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Van Dalen has been the best threat for the Penn offense in 2009.

The senior leads the ground attack with 185 rushes for 1,144 yards (6.2 avg.) and 13 TDs, while four other players have also amassed nearly or more than 300 yards rushing apiece.

Van Dalen has also completed 52-of-127 passes for 1,184 yards and 12 scores. Crouch, with 28 receptions for 822 yards and ten scores, and **Bernard Luster** (Jr., Corinth, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC), with 15 catches for 205 yards and two scores, have been a potent 1-2 punch in the receiving corps.

COACH HAFNER SAYS

On the Waldorf game:

“Our kids played hard and were inspired to send the seniors out well on Senior Day. We played well in all aspects of the game.”

On St. Francis (Ill.):

“St. Francis is a team whose record is not indicative of how good they really are. It will be battle as it is their Senior Day. They always play hard and we will have to play solid and not turn the ball over.”

On the 2009 Senior Class:

“This class is the class that stepped out on a limb and have turned this program around. They trusted us and our program and have become great young men along the way.”

Goolsby's arm.

He has completed 191-of-350 passes for 2,333 yards and 23 touchdowns and just seven interceptions. He has shared the wealth with four players over 100 yards receiving, highlighted by Fiske's 878 yards on 77 catches (seven scores). Palmer has been the big-play target, hauling in 25 receptions for 566 yards (22.6 yards per catch) and a team-high eight touchdowns.

Not to be outdone, Krisch has rushed well with 904 yards and seven scores.

STATESMEN TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: **Trevon Greene** (Sr., Gaffney, S.C., Gaffney HS) and **Dale Woods** (Jr., Southaven, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) lead Penn with 68 stops each. Woods also leads the team with 24.5 tackles for loss, eight sacks, and three forced fumbles.

Cody Hackett (Sr., State Center, West Marshall HS) tops the Statesmen with four interceptions.

ST. FRANCIS (ILL.) TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: Brenton Valentine tops the Fighting Saints with 61 tackles, while Dan Heimerdinger has 57 stops.

Ryan Ramos has a team-best ten tackles for loss, while Marco Mendoza has five sacks, and Wayne Johnson leads the squad with four interceptions.

STATESMEN TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: **Cam Shearon** (So., St. Peters, Mo., Francis Howell Central HS) is 4-of-10 in field goals and 31-of-36 in extra points.

Penn is utilizing two individuals in the punt game. Hackett has punted 25 times for a 37.3 yard average, while **Michael Harris** (Sr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) has punted 21 times for a 33.4 yard average.

Andrew Harris (Jr., Horn Lake, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) leads the team in return average with a 20.7 yard kickoff average (31 attempts) and a 13.1 yard punt average (14 attempts). He has returned one punt for a touchdown.

ST. FRANCIS (ILL.) TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: Patrick Wright is 13-of-17 in field goals and 33-of-36 in extra points.

Wright is also the team's punter, averaging 34.3 yards over 45 attempts.

Fiske and Mike Anthony have been sharing punt return responsibilities. Anthony has returned seven for an 8.1 average, while Fiske has returned seven for an 8.0 clip. Johnson has returned the most kickoffs (22 total) with a 19.4 yard average per attempt, while Fiske has taken 14 returns for an average of 23.3 yards.
