Mahaska Communication Group (MCG) will also provide television coverage for all home games on its cable network.

SERIES HISTORY: This is the first-ever gridiron meeting between William Penn and South Dakota.

COACHES: Todd Hafner is in his sixth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 26-29 career record.

Hafner led his 2008 squad to a 7-4 record, including a 5-2 Midwest League mark. The seven wins are the most for the program since 1976. For his efforts, Hafner was named Midwest League Coach of the Year

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when the team was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 58 all-conference players and eight All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

Ed Meierkort is in his sixth season as head football coach at South Dakota and enters this campaign with a 39-18 record, the best five-year start for any coach in program history.

The team has owned winning records all five years under Coach Meierkort.

Meierkort, who is 94-73 all-time as a collegiate coach, has led his Coyote team to more than 100 school records. The program is in its second year of their transition to NCAA Division I FCS status.

Last year's team ranked in the top ten nationally in the FCS in scoring (37.5 points), total offense (461.8 yards), and rushing offense (240.1 yards). Eleven players earned all-Great West Conference honors and six players were Great West Players of the Week.

The team is dominant at home under Meierkort with a 26-2 mark.

THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK: The Statesmen failed to convert some golden opportunities in a 22-14 loss to Georgetown (Ky.) in the first annual Big River Bowl.

Ryan Van Dalen (Sr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) rushed 16 times for 89 yards and a touchdown and completed four-of-12 passes for 128 yards and a score.

Cody Hackett (Sr., State Center, West Marshall HS) had an interception, while **Trevon Greene** (Sr., Gaffney, S.C., Gaffney HS) led the defense with 11 tackles and one and a half sacks.

Penn unfortunately lost possession twice at the Tiger goal line with an interception in the second quarter and a fumble in the fourth quarter.

THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Penn fell behind big early and could not rally for enough fourth quarter points in falling 28-14 to Marian (Ind.) in week two of 2008.

The Statesmen trailed 28-0 entering the final stanza, but Van Dalen scored on a rushing touchdown and then hooked up with **DeMarco Sanders** (So., Horn Lake, Miss., Horn Lake HS) for a passing touchdown to cut the lead in half by game's end.

Van Dalen rushed for 52 yards and passed for 207 yards. **Skylar Crouch** (Sr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS) had two receptions for 102 yards.

Greene recorded 13 tackles to top the defensive effort.

THE COYOTES A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: South Dakota dominated St. Ambrose 52-0 in its 2008 opener.

The Coyotes put up 547 yards in total offense, including 299 yards rushing and 248 yards through the air.

Noah Shepard completed ten-of-12 passes for 180 yards and three touchdowns. Dan Skelly was his top target with four catches for 98 yards.

Chris Ganius rushed nine times for 141 yards and two scores.

South Dakota did not commit a turnover and forced the Fighting Bees into 11 punts.

STATESMEN TOP RETURNING OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Van Dalen was a tremendous multiple-option quarterback in 2008.

He was extremely effective on the ground, rushing 187 times for 1,158 yards (6.2 avg.) and 18 scores.

Through the air, he completed 52-of-126 passes for 995 yards and nine touchdowns.

Sanders is the top returning running back, rushing 71 times for 286 yards and three touchdowns.

COACH HAFNER SAYS

On the Big River Bowl vs. Georgetown:

"We played hard and did a lot of good things for the first game of the season. Unfortunately, we also had a lot of errors that are correctable. After watching film, we felt we should have won, but we did not take advantage of opportunities and did not make a play at the end when we needed to."

On South Dakota:

"South Dakota is a very experienced team and the fact they are Division I-AA, they have very good players. We have to be ready for the speed and physicality of the game and need to play very hard and get some breaks and take advantage of those breaks. We hope to represent Penn in best light we can."

Crouch is Penn's best returning receiver, leading the 2008 team in catches (19), yards (644), and touchdowns (5).

SOUTH DAKOTA TOP RETURNING OFFENSIVE PLAYERS:

Shepard had a great first season as the Coyote quarterback, completing 137-of-234 passes for 2,000 yards and 15 touchdowns.

He also rushed for 645 yards and a team-best 13 touchdowns.

Ganious rushed for a team-best 755 yards and nine scores, while Isaac Newton had 483 yards and seven touchdowns.

Skelly caught 47 passes for 880 yards and nine TDs.

STATESMEN TOP RETURNING DEFENSIVE PLAYERS:

Trevon Greene (Sr., Gaffney, S.C., Gaffney HS) led Penn with 93 tackles last year, while **Damon Harrison** (So., Lake Charles, La., Lake Charles Boston HS) is the next highest returner with 47 stops.

Flukers tops all returners with four interceptions last year. Penn forced 28 turnovers in 2008 (2.5 per game).

SOUTH DAKOTA TOP RETURNING DEFENSIVE PLAYERS:

Wayne Curry was third on the team in tackles in 2008 with 56 stops and second with 11 tackles for loss. He also had 4.5 sacks.

Mychal Bogan had a squad-best three interceptions a year ago.

STATESMEN TOP RETURNING SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS:

Cam Shearon (So., St. Peters, Mo., Francis Howell Central HS) was 7-9 in extra points and 3-6 in field goals a year ago.

Michael Harris (Sr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) punted 52 times for an average of 31.1 yards in 2008.

Crouch led all returners last year with a 10.3 yard average over 17 punt returns, while Sanders led the team in kickoff return average with 24.0 yards per over 22 returns.

SOUTH DAKOTA RETURNING TOP SPECIAL TEAMS

PLAYERS: Justin Veazie returns as the team's placekicker, making four-of-11 field goals and 46-of-49 extra points in 2008.

Jeremy Blount is back after averaging 10.6 yards per punt return and 24.5 yards per kick return last year.
