SERIES HISTORY: Penn trails the all-time series against Quincy 6-2, including last year's 45-42 loss in the 2008 season finale.

The Statesmen offense put up 359 yards and scored six touchdowns, but the Hawk offense was just a little better. Quincy netted 514 yards and Alex Beard hit the game-winning 33-yard field goal as time expired to lift the Hawks to the win.

Ryan Van Dalen (Sr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) had career highs in yards (224) and touchdowns (4) to pace his team.

The loss ended not only Penn's season but also any chance of at least sharing the league crown with St. Ambrose.

STATESMEN IN NAIA RANKING: With last week's 42-16 win over Taylor, Penn has moved back onto the national radar with one national vote in the NAIA's first regular season poll.

The Statesmen are unofficially tied for 37th with Bacone (Okla.) and Iowa programs Grand View and Graceland.

COACHES: Todd Hafner is in his sixth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 26-29 career record.

Hafner led his 2008 squad to a 7-4 record, including a 5-2 Midwest League mark. The seven wins are the most for the program since 1976. For his efforts, Hafner was named Midwest League Coach of the Year.

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when the team was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 58 all-conference players and eight All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

Bill Terlisner is in his tenth season as head football coach at Quincy and enters this week with a 40-60 record.

Terlisner has led the program to three consecutive winning seasons (all 6-5 records), the first time the feat has been accomplished in school history.

He actually began his coaching career at Penn in 1992 as the offensive and defensive line coach and then moved on Quincy in 1993 where he has been ever since.

Terlisner is a 1991 graduate of Quincy with a degree in history.

THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK: Penn ran all over Taylor to the tune of a 42-16 victory last week.

The Statesmen started slowly, but eventually got going and dominated the Trojans with 421 rushing yards, including 112 by Van Dalen (3 TDs). The team's yardage tally is the most since joining the NAIA in 2001.

The Statesmen defense was also active with five interceptions, tying the most since joining the NAIA.

QUINCY LAST WEEK: Quincy failed to hold onto its fourth-quarter lead in falling to Walsh 24-16.

Trevor Durham passed for 144 yards, but the Hawks' best player was their kicker as Beard connected on three field goals of 38, 42, and 20 yards to earn Midwest League Special Teams Player of the Week honors.

THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Penn rallied to knock off Taylor 13-10 in Week Four of the 2008 campaign.

Penn trailed 10-3 entering the final quarter, but a touchdown pass by Van Dalen to **DeMarco Sanders** (So., Horn Lake, Miss., Horn Lake HS) on the first play of the quarter tied the score.

Cam Shearon (So., St. Peters, Mo., Francis Howell Central HS) then hit his second field goal of the day, a 37-yarder, with 4:37 left to lift the squad to victory. For his efforts, he was named MWL Special Teams POW.

QUINCY A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Quincy held on to knock off Walsh 27-25 in Week Four of 2008.

Sam Donatucci had a huge game, passing for 367 yards and two scores, while Corey Williams was equally strong on the ground with 140 yards and a score on just 17 rushes.

Beard also hit field goals of 20 and 27 yards.

STATESMEN TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Van Dalen has been the spark in the Penn offense thus far in 2009.

The senior leads the ground attack with 59 rushes for 239 yards (4.1 avg.) and four TDs, while three other players have already amassed 100 yards rushing.

Van Dalen has also completed 12-of-37 passes for 251 yards and a score. **Skyler Crouch** (Sr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS), with five receptions for 101 yards, and **Bernard Luster** (Jr., Corinth, Miss., Northwest Mississippi

COACH HAFNER SAYS

On the Taylor game:

“Once we finally overcame the early mistakes, our defense settled in and did very well. Offensively, we did a lot of good things from start to end. It was a day that we can look back on and feel really good about.”

On Quincy:

“Quincy is a lot like us because they are hard to prepare for. They do things different than everyone else we play and that makes it tough on a defense to prepare on a short week. We are hoping to play solid defense and not give up the big play. We think that what we do will offset what they are good at. We are looking to execute well and come away with a nice win to start the league season.”

CC), with four catches for 113 yards and a score, have been a nice 1-2 punch in the receiving corps.

QUINCY TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Williams is pacing the offense with 223 rushing yards.

Donatucci and Durham have shared time at quarterback, combining for 374 yards and a pair of scores.

The Hawks have several options in the passing game with three players over 80 yards receiving and seven players with at least three receptions.

STATESMEN TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: Kris Austin (Sr., Oxford, Miss., Lafayette HS) leads Penn with 20 tackles, while Dale Woods (Jr., Southaven, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) is on his heels with 18 stops, including a team-best 8.5 for loss.

Woods also tops Penn with 2.5 sacks, while Cody Hackett (Sr., State Center, West Marshall HS) has a squad-best three interceptions.

QUINCY TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: Nate Toole tops the Hawks with 31 stops, including a team-best 8.5 for loss.

Erik Wilson and Todd Jordan both have one interception each.

STATESMEN TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: Shearon and Ian Harris (Fr., Buffalo Grove, Ill., Harper CC) continue to share kicking responsibilities. Shearon is 1-3 in field goals and 4-4 in extra points, while Harris is 0-1 in field goals and 1-3 in extra points.

Penn is also utilizing two individuals in the punt game. Hackett has punted nine times for a 37.1 yard average, while Michael Harris (Sr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) has punted nine times for a 32.7 yard average.

Andrew Harris (Jr., Horn Lake, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) leads the team in kickoff return average with a 16.5 yard average.

QUINCY TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: Beard is well on his way to earning postseason honors for his placekicking as he is 6-7 in field goals and 1-2 in extra points.

Kyle Homeyer has punted 15 times for an average of 35.6 yards.

Adam Dry is the team's best option in the return game with ten kickoff returns for an average of 17.4 yards. Josh Mitchell has returned four punts for an average of 5.2 yards.
