SERIES HISTORY: Penn leads the all-time series against Trinity International 4-3 and has won the past four meetings, including last year's 25-24 victory in Illinois.

The Statesmen opened strong with a 16-3 lead, but had to hold on for victory, keeping the Trojans scoreless over the final 14:25 of regulation.

Ryan Van Dalen (Sr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) hooked up with **Skylar Crouch** (Sr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS) for two touchdowns, while Van Dalen also rushed for another score.

STATESMEN IN NAIA RANKING: With last week's 35-30 win over Quincy, Penn remains on the national radar with one national vote in the NAIA's first regular season poll.

The Statesmen are unofficially tied for 37th with six other programs.

COACHES: Todd Hafner is in his sixth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 26-29 career record.

Hafner led his 2008 squad to a 7-4 record, including a 5-2 Midwest League mark. The seven wins are the most for the program since 1976. For his efforts, Hafner was named Midwest League Coach of the Year

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when the team was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 58 all-conference players and eight All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

Mike Gims is in his second year as head coach at Trinity International and owns a 1-10 record entering this season.

THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK: A strange contest ended in favor of Penn as the Statesmen won 35-30 over Quincy in the league opener for both teams.

Van Dalen found Crouch twice for touchdowns of 80 and 51 yards as Crouch was named MWL Offensive Player of the Week.

Penn's special teams also made a big impact as **John Bryan** (Fr., Cary, Ill., Cary Grove HS) recovered a fumbled punt in the endzone and **Andrew Harris** (Jr., Horn Lake, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) returned a punt 47 yards for a score.

The Statesmen survived by stopping the Hawks on the final play of the game.

TRINITY INTERNATIONAL LAST WEEK: The Trojans could not recover from an early deficit in falling 23-14 to Waldorf.

Cole Bamburger had a nice day on the ground with 127 yards, while Daniel Beals passed for 134 yards.

Trinity International sacked the Waldorf quarterback six times in the loss.

THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Penn overcame four turnovers to drop Trinity International 25-24 in Week Five of 2008.

Crouch had two big receptions for 139 yards, while **Cam Shearon** (So., St. Peters, Mo., Francis Howell Central HS) also hit a 32-yard field goal in the first quarter.

Van Dalen threw two touchdowns, but also had an interception and two fumbles. **DeMarco Sanders** (So., Horn Lake, Miss., Horn Lake HS) coughed up the ball once as well.

Penn also scored off a Trojan fumble in the first stanza.

TRINITY INTERNATIONAL A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: The Trojans rallied for 21 second-half points, but it was not enough to knock off Penn in Week Five of 2008.

Quarterback Jakob Moreno accounted for all three Trinity International touchdowns, rushing for two and passing for another. He finished with 225 yards on the day, including 203 through the air.

STATESMEN TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Van Dalen has been the spark in the Penn offense thus far in 2009.

The senior leads the ground attack with 67 rushes for 261 yards (3.9 avg.) and four TDs, while four other players have also amassed over 100 yards rushing.

Van Dalen has also completed 20-of-52 passes for 469 yards and three scores. Crouch, with nine receptions for 244 yards and two scores, and **Bernard Luster** (Jr., Corinth, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC), with five

TRINITY INTERNATIONAL TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS:

Bamburger is pacing the offense with 185 rushing yards.

Beals and Kindrick Dent have shared time at quarterback, combining for 422 yards and a pair of scores.

Several different players have caught passes for the Trojans with Nigel Pinson leading the squad with 99 yards on four receptions.

STATESMEN TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: Trevon Greene

(Sr., Gaffney, S.C., Gaffney HS) leads Penn with 28 tackles, while **Dale Woods** (Jr., Southaven, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) is next with 23 stops, including a team-best 12.5 for loss.

Woods also tops Penn with 3.5 sacks and two forced fumbles, while **Cody Hackett** (Sr., State Center, West Marshall HS) has a squad-best three interceptions.

TRINITY INTERNATIONAL TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS:

Pete Miller tops the Trojans with 32 stops, while Tyler Boblit has 31 stops, including a team-best nine for loss.

Miller is also leading Trinity International with three interceptions.

STATESMEN TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS:

Shearon and **Ian Harris** (Fr., Buffalo Grove, Ill., Harper CC) continue to share kicking responsibilities. Shearon is 2-4 in field goals and 6-8 in extra points, while Harris is 0-1 in field goals and 1-3 in extra points.

Penn is also utilizing two individuals in the punt game. Hackett has punted 12 times for a 37.9 yard average, while **Michael Harris** (Sr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) has punted 12 times for a 33.2 yard average.

Harris leads the team in return average with an 18.4 yard kickoff average (18 attempts) and a 31.0 punt average (three attempts). He has returned one punt for a touchdown.

TRINITY INTERNATIONAL TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS:

ERS: Josiah Schillinger handles the placekicking responsibilities for the Trojans, going 3-3 in extra points and 1-2 in field goals.

Josh Myers has punted 24 times for an average of 30.3 yards.

LaParish Lewis is the team's leading kick returner with a 14.9 average over eight attempts. Four different players have returned punts for Trinity International thus far in 2009.
