SERIES HISTORY: Despite being rivals in all other sports, the two programs have never met on the gridiron.

COACHES: Todd Hafner is in his sixth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 26-29 career record.

Hafner led his 2008 squad to a 7-4 record, including a 5-2 Midwest League mark. The seven wins are the most for the program since 1976. For his efforts, Hafner was named Midwest League Coach of the Year

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when the team was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 58 all-conference players and eight All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

Mike Woodley is in his second year as head football coach at Grand View, entering the campaign with a 2-8 record.

Woodley has spent 26 of his 31 seasons coaching in Iowa, including nine years at fellow MWL school St. Ambrose. He comes to Grand View from Sam Rayburn HS (Texas) where he served as athletic director and head football coach for four years.

An inductee to the Iowa High School Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame, he is also a Hall of Fame member of the University of Northern Iowa and Waterloo East HS. He has won Coach of the Year honors at each school he has coached

and was the NAIA District 15 Coach of the Year while at St. Ambrose.

THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK: Penn pummeled Trinity International 49-13 in an MSFA crossover game last Saturday.

Ryan Van Dalen (Sr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) threw three touchdowns and also ran for two, all in the first half, as he tallied 267 yards of total offense.

Skyler Crouch (Sr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS) was his top receiver, hauling in three passes for 119 yards and two scores.

The Statesmen put up 35 points in the first quarter and added two more touchdowns in the second stanza to cruise to victory.

GRAND VIEW LAST WEEK: The Vikings scored 31 first quarter points to pound Waldorf 45-13 in league action last Saturday.

Daryl Ford paced the offense with 134 yards and two touchdowns on 15 rushes, while Taylor Bennett threw for 111 yards.

The Grand View defense forced three interceptions, while Titus Bland also returned a punt for a touchdown.

THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: Penn watched as St. Ambrose scored 20 unanswered points to start the game and held on for a 41-21 victory over the Statesmen in Week Six of 2008.

Penn made it interesting with 14 unanswered points of its own to cut the deficit to six at 20-14 in the third quarter, but could pull no closer.

Lincoln Cavanagh had a big game with 139 rushing yards, while Van Dalen rushed and passed for one touchdown each.

GRAND VIEW A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK: The Vikings were run over by Kentucky Wesleyan 34-13 in Week Six of 2008.

Grand View was outgained 596-215 (321 KWU rushing yards) and had five turnovers, but was still in the game entering the fourth stanza, trailing just 24-13.

Lawrence Furlow rushed 19 times for 130 rushing yards and one score.

STATESMEN TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Van Dalen has been the spark in the Penn offense thus far in 2009.

The senior leads the ground attack with 74 rushes for 364 yards (4.9 avg.) and six TDs, while four other players have also amassed over 100 yards rushing.

Van Dalen has also completed 24-of-56 passes for 633 yards and six scores. Crouch, with 12 receptions for 363 yards and

four scores, and **Bernard Luster** (Jr., Corinth, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC), with six catches for 165 yards and two scores, have been a nice 1-2 punch in the receiving corps.

GRAND VIEW TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS: Ford is pacing the Viking offense with 426 rushing yards and six scores.

COACH HAFNER SAYS

On the Trinity International game:

"I feel that we played about as good as we could have played against Trinity International. Our effort and execution was great minus a few fumbles. I felt everything went really well on Saturday."

On Grand View:

"Grand View is very good, much better than a second-year team should be. They have some very talented players and some older players that are well-seasoned. They are well-coached and they have a plan for all aspects of the game and they execute that plan very well."

Bennett has led the team from behind center by completing 36-of-64 passes for 408 yards and three touchdowns.

Brett Opdahl and Nick Eaton are the top two receiving options for the Vikings. Opdahl has team bests in receptions (14) and yards (180) with one score, while Eaton has pulled down 13 catches for 133 yards.

STATESMEN TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: **Trevon Greene** (Sr., Gaffney, S.C., Gaffney HS) leads Penn with 33 tackles, while **Dale Woods** (Jr., Southaven, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) is next with 28 stops, including a team-best 13 for loss.

Woods also tops Penn with 3.5 sacks and two forced fumbles, while **Cody Hackett** (Sr., State Center, West Marshall HS) has a squad-best three interceptions.

GRAND VIEW TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS: E.J. Peterson tops the Vikings with 39 tackles, while Raytron Lamar is next with 30 stops. Taylor Andersen heads the squad with 6.5 tackles for loss and is tied with Peterson with three sacks.

Bland has three interceptions to lead all Viking defensive players.

STATESMEN TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: **Cam Shearon** (So., St. Peters, Mo., Francis Howell Central HS) appears to have taken over the team's placekicking responsibilities. Shearon is 2-5 in field goals and 13-15 in extra points.

Penn is utilizing two individuals in the punt game. Hackett has punted 13 times for a 38.1 yard average, while **Michael Harris** (Sr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) has punted 13 times for a 33.5 yard average.

Harris leads the team in return average with an 18.6 yard kickoff average (20 attempts) and an 18.6 punt average (five attempts). He has returned one punt for a touchdown.

GRAND VIEW TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS: Blake Steil handles the placekicking responsibilities for the Vikings, going 14-15 in extra points and 3-5 in field goals.

Trace Ball has punted 23 times for an average of 33.5 yards.

Bland is also the team's leading returner with a 36.9 average over seven kickoff attempts and a 19.0 clip over ten punt attempts.
