**SERIES HISTORY:** Penn trails in its all-time football series against St. Ambrose 12-7 and has dropped 11 in a row, dating back to 1931.

The Statesmen fell 41-21 to the Fighting Bees at home last year. Lincoln Cavanagh had 139 rushing yards, but the St. Ambrose offense pounded out 528 yards to pull away from Penn in the second half.

**COACHES:** Todd Hafner is in his sixth year as head football coach at Penn, entering the campaign with a 26-29 career record.

Hafner led his 2008 squad to a 7-4 record, including a 5-2 Midwest League mark. The seven wins are the most for the program since 1976. For his efforts, Hafner was named Midwest League Coach of the Year

He also guided Penn to the program's first winning season in 29 years in 2005 when the team was 6-5. Over his four years, Hafner has produced 58 all-conference players and eight All-Americans.

Hafner graduated from Pittsburg State University in 1994 with a degree in mathematics (minor in coaching).

Hafner started his coaching career at Carl Junction HS in Carl Junction, Mo., where he was an assistant football coach for two years. From there he moved on to Southwest Baptist where he was a graduate assistant for one year.

Hafner then returned to Carl Junction to take up the head coaching position. He held it for four years before taking an assistant coaching job at Emporia State in Emporia, Kan. Hafner was the offensive coordinator for two years before adding assistant head coach to his title.

Mike Magistrelli is in his third year as the head football coach for St. Ambrose, entering this campaign with a 16-7 record.

Magistrelli has led the Fighting Bees to back-to-back Midwest League crowns and trips to the NAIA playoffs in his first two seasons.

A two-time all-conference quarterback at Coe College, Magistrelli began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at St. Ambrose from 1997-1999. He returned to Coe in 1999 and served as the quarterbacks coach and recruiting coordinator for three seasons. In 2000, his quarterback set the single-season Iowa Conference record by throwing for 2,275 yards. Magistrelli was promoted to defensive coordinator at Coe in 2001, and the following year, the Kohawks won their first conference championship in school history.

After five seasons at Coe, Magistrelli came back to St. Ambrose in 2004 as the defensive coordinator. He remained in that position through the 2006 season before taking the head coaching job in 2007.

**THE STATESMEN LAST WEEK:** Penn rolled over Iowa Wesleyan for a 44-14 Homecoming win last Saturday.

The Statesmen, who extended their winning streak over Iowa Wesleyan to ten games and have won six Homecoming games in a row, produced 497 yards of offense.

**Ryan Van Dalen** (Sr., Oskaloosa, Oskaloosa HS) rushed for 141 yards and passed for another 144 and **Skyler Crouch** (Sr., Payson, Utah, Payson HS) caught four passes for 126 yards and two touchdowns.

**ST. AMBROSE LAST WEEK:** The Fighting Bees put on a clinic against Waldorf with a 66-0 victory last Saturday.

St. Ambrose outgained the Warriors 433-49 as Matt Ardiente led the offense with 105 yards rushing and four touchdowns.

**THE STATESMEN A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK:** Penn claimed another huge victory for the improving program by knocking off McKendree (Ill.) 17-14 in Week Eight of 2008.

In a game dominated by both teams' rushing attacks (578 total rushing yards), the Statesmen rallied with ten second-half points for the win.

Cavanagh (133) and Van Dalen (102) both rushed for over 100 yards and Penn recovered five fumbles to ensure the victory.

**ST. AMBROSE A YEAR AGO THIS WEEK:** The Fighting Bees failed to move the ball on the ground and the passing game could not make up the difference in falling 21-7 to McKendree in Week Seven of 2008.

St. Ambrose finished with just 179 yards of offense and were held in the red on the ground with -14 yards rushing.

The team forced four Tiger fumbles, but manufactured just seven points from the miscues.

**STATESMEN TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS:** Van Dalen continues to be the spark in the Penn offense thus far in 2009.

The senior leads the ground attack with 117 rushes for 639 yards (5.5 avg.) and ten TDs, while four other players have also amassed over 100 yards rushing.

Van Dalen has also completed 39-of-91 passes for 906 yards and nine scores. Crouch, with 20 receptions for 566 yards and seven scores, and **Bernard Luster** (Jr., Corinth, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC), with nine

## COACH HAFNER SAYS

### *On the Iowa Wesleyan game:*

"I thought we played as good as we could have played on both sides against Iowa Wesleyan. We bounced back well after a tough loss the week before. The crowd support was great for Homecoming and we had a lot of fun."

### *On St. Ambrose:*

"St. Ambrose is a good football team. They really haven't changed anything despite moving some people around and losing some guys to graduation. They continue to do a lot of good things. Our top priority is to take care of the ball and try to get a couple of takeaways. We have proven if we take care of the ball, we can beat anyone, so we have to do better there. We have to keep mistakes to a minimum."

catches for 183 yards and two scores, have been a potent 1-2 punch in the receiving corps.

**ST. AMBROSE TOP OFFENSIVE PLAYERS:** The Fighting Bee offense has been going as far as Michael Hayward's arm will allow it and that has been pretty far.

Hayward has completed 61-of-130 passes for 1,196 yards and eight touchdowns. Jacob Rohde has been his top target with 21 receptions for 425 yards and five scores. It has not just been the Hayward-Rohde show, however, as four other Fighting Bees also have over 100 yards receiving.

It is also running back-by-committee as five different players have rushed for over 100 yards, including Ardiente, who has 271 yards and six scores.

**STATESMEN TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS:** **Kris Austin** (Sr., Oxford, Miss., Lafayette HS) leads Penn with 39 tackles, while **Trevon Greene** (Sr., Gaffney, S.C., Gaffney HS) and **Dale Woods** (Jr., Southaven, Miss., Northwest Mississippi CC) are next with 38 stops each. Woods leads the team with 16.5 tackles for loss, five sacks, and two forced fumbles.

**Cody Hackett** (Sr., State Center, West Marshall HS) and **Dominic Peace** (Fr., Pensacola, Fla., J.R. Arnold HS) both have a squad-best three interceptions.

**ST. AMBROSE TOP DEFENSIVE PLAYERS:** Jim Forner paces the Fighting Bees with 45 tackles, while Zach Hughes has 36 stops. Forner also tops the team with five stops for a loss.

Steve Herbert and Jason Bradford both have three quarterback sacks and Colin Suiter has picked off two passes thus far in 2009.

**STATESMEN TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS:** **Cam Shearon** (So., St. Peters, Mo., Francis Howell Central HS) is 4-9 in field goals and 20-22 in extra points.

Penn is utilizing two individuals in the punt game. Hackett has punted 16 times for a 38.4 yard average, while **Michael Harris** (Sr., Panora, Iowa Central CC) has punted 16 times for a 34.2 yard average.

Harris leads the team in return average with a 19.6 yard kickoff average (23 attempts) and a 17.6 yard punt average (eight attempts). He has returned one punt for a touchdown.

**ST. AMBROSE TOP SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS:** Patrick Schmadeke has been a very proficient kicker for the Fighting Bees, making 9-of-ten field goals and 14-of-16 extra points.

Scott Langel is solid in the punting game with 31 attempts for an average of 38.5 yards.

James Hannah-White is the team's leading kickoff returner with a 20.5 yard average over 13 attempts, but has actually performed better in punt return action with ten returns for an average of 26.5 yards.
