Student-Athlete Advisory Committee

A student-athlete advisory committee (SAAC) is a committee made up of student-athletes to provide insight on their experience. The SAAC also offers input on NAIA rules, regulations and policies that affect the student-athletes, while establishing greater communication between the students and the administration at William Penn.



The campus committee is meant to serve as an instrument of communication among student-athletes, coaches, and athletics administrators on issues to improve the student-athlete experience and promote growth and education through sports participation.

SAAC's Mission Statement

SAAC Members

- 2 representatives from each varsity team consisting of 1 Upperclassman and 1 Underclassman with a 2.5 GPA or higher
- Members are selected by their coaches based on leadership qualities, ensuring that the nominee is well-respected within their team and will be responsible for relaying information
- Members will be required to attend monthly meetings and participate in all activities unless academics or sports interfere
- Members must act as liaisons between their team and the committee, reporting all learned material back to their teammates and collecting input
- Members must be willing and able to think creatively to come up with new activities and visions for SAAC
